THE MATTER

Fraudulent Claim Suits Threaten Company's Business and Brand

A major U.S. insurance carrier was sued for payments on claims involving nine catastrophic injury cases. The company called on Katten Muchin Rosenman LLP to pursue a counter suit against an attorney and a former insurance adjuster who were involved in the claims, to show that the claims were fraudulent. The complex, difficult case, filed in U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan, involved over 300 separate events related to the nine injury cases.

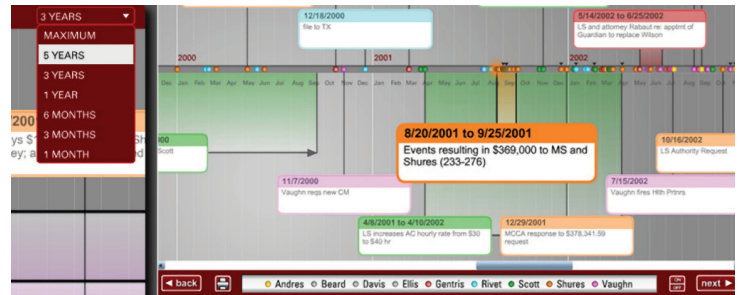

This added great flexibility for Katten's trial team, and eliminated a dependence on CaseSight for last minute changes, helping make Katten's case development process more efficient and streamlined. CaseSight's presentation could also be dynamically changed by the attorneys during the presentation for ultimate flexibility.

This interactive and dynamic solution allowed the attorneys to move seamlessly between showing the broad, coordinated trends that indicated the fraud, to the fine details of individual events, which further demonstrated to the jury the fraudulent nature and purpose of the claimants' actions, and helped seal the verdict.
